

THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER HAS ADOPTED SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING 2017

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING COLLECTION PROGRAM ALLOWS CANS, BOTTLES, CARDBOARD AND ALL OTHER PAPER TO BE MIXED TOGETHER FOR RECYCLING. ALL OF THESE ITEMS CAN GO INTO THE SAME RECYCLING CONTAINER.

PAPER – Recycle office paper, filed folders, junk mail, envelopes, flyers, newspapers and inserts, magazines, catalogs, paperbacks, phone books, wrapping paper, paper bags, tissue boxes, cookie boxes, paper towel cores, toilet tissue rolls and frozen food boxes.

Cartons and boxes used for milk, juice, soup, broth, CAN NOT BE RECYCLED

PLASTIC – Plastic caps and lids larger than 3” in diameter are acceptable. The smallest acceptable plastic container is a 6 to 8 oz. yogurt cup. Containers must be empty. Acceptable plastics are marked on the bottom with a



METAL - Recycle aluminum and steel (tin) cans, loose metal jar lids, steel bottle caps, pie plates and trays. All containers must be clean of all contaminants.

GLASS – Recycle glass bottles and jars with caps and lids removed. Recycle loose metal caps and lids. Bottles and jars must be empty and clean.

RECYCABLE MATERIAL WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF PLACED IN A PLASTIC BAG

ALL APPOINTMENTS MUST BE MADE BY THE PREVIOUS WEDNESDAY

YARD WASTE

WILL BE PICKED EVERY MONDAY STARTING APRIL 3, 2017 THROUGH
DECEMBER 11, 2017 WITH THE EXCEPTION OF

MAY 29, 2017 (MEMORIAL DAY)
SEPTEMBER 4, 2017 (LABOR DAY)

Yard Waste MUST be recycled in biodegradable paper bags or trash receptacles no larger than 33 gallons. **Plastic bags are NOT acceptable.** Brush must be in 4’ lengths maximum and 4” in diameter no heavier than 25 lbs per bundle – all bundles must be tied.

METAL PICK UP

FEBRUARY 2, MAY 4, AUGUST 3, NOVEMBER 2, 2017

HEAVY BULK ITEMS – such as sofas, dressers, beds, etc. will be picked up every Friday. Excessive amounts of bulk items will require the homeowner to obtain a dumpster at their own cost.

ELECTRONICS – will no longer be picked up curbside as they can no longer be disposed of with regular trash. Stores that sell electronics such as Best Buy, PC Richard and Staples accept items for recycling. CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL – Limit two 33 gallon containers (Fridays only) all construction material must be free of nails.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP – January 8 and January 15, 2018 – NO plastic bags are allowed and the tree must be free of all lights and decorations.
