The Fund is strictly limited to assisting residents of Hunterdon, Morris, Somerset, Suburban Essex, Sussex and Warren counties. Single adults must have had an annual income below \$35,560 without dependents or no more than \$88,128 with two or more dependents. Two adult households must have had an annual income below \$52,444 without dependents or no more than \$103,836 with two or more dependents.
