MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way had questions regarding the drainage issues at the corner of Gormley and Kakeout Road; he suggested that the drain be relocated. Mr. Lampmann noted that he will have Paul Darmofalski, Borough Engineer inspect the area and make a recommendation.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

Councilman McNear noted that he attended a program on Thursday, March 10, 2016, given in conjunction with the Morris County Sheriff's Office, the Bloomingdale Police Department and the Borough of Butler Police. The program was on steps that can be taken to avoid child abduction, kidnapping and sexual exploitation of children. When he attended the Board of Health meeting, questions arose regarding Massage Parlors in the Borough of Butler and what the local requirements are and if they are still in effect. Mr. Oostdyk explained that the State of New Jersey has taken over the licensing process; therefore, the local ordinances were repealed. Mr. McNear wanted to notify the Mayor and Council that the Board of Health members have been receiving various questions regarding the recent series of earthquakes and asked about notification. Mr. Lampmann explained that the recent NIXLE alert given was in response to the police desk being inundated with phone calls. Additionally, he explained that there is a procedure in place for handling any emergencies. Mayor Alviene added that all the appropriate agencies were notified and the Borough has not received any notification of property damages. Child health services examined three children as part of the health department services.

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Councilman Meier reporting on the Electric Utility noted testing has been scheduled for the various vehicles. Primary upgrade projects are ongoing, poles were transferred due to a fallen tree, new poles were set and transferred in various locations and installation of new LED street lighting continues. Repairs were made where needed. In Riverdale and West Milford, all was quiet, all meters were read and recorded, delinquent accounts were addressed.

Councilman Verdonik the Water Committee met up at the Water facilities by the Reservoir, a tour was taken to review the Capital projects. The Committee is working on a five-year plan to be presented shortly. The Gifford Street water main replacement project is scheduled to begin mid-April.

Councilman Regis reporting on the Fire Department noted that there were 16 general alarms of various types including 4 fires on one day. The Police Department for the month of January responded to 27 motor vehicle accidents 202 summons were issued, 3 driving while intoxicated arrests and 36 arrests for various violations. He wanted to inform the Mayor and Council that a pawnshop had recently opened up and he would like to discuss putting regulations in place for the operation of these shops. Mr. Oostdyk will provide samples for the April Workshop meeting.

Councilman Fox noted that with the Budget being introduced, the Roads Committee would do an inspection of the Borough's roads and determine which roads will be repaved this year.

Council President Vath reporting on Finance noted that the 2016 Municipal Budget is up for introduction this evening. The total budget for the year is \$11,578,383.00, which equates to an increase of \$29.40 on the average assessed home at \$252,369.00. The Water Utility budget will be \$2,037,192.00 and the Electric Utility will be \$20,972,812.00. He would like to commend the department heads, the Mayor and Council, Jim Kozimor, Jim Lampmann and the staff, as they have been fiscally responsible over the last few years.

Mayor Alviene noted that all the people involved with the preparation of the 2016 budget did an outstanding job, as the increase is nominal.

Mr. Lampmann provided the Mayor and Council with an update on a grant presentation was made for a water main replacement on Manning Avenue, he was informed that pending the vote of the Morris County Freeholders, the full grant amount was approved in the amount of \$80,000.00.

Councilman McNear expressed concern for Mr. Budesheim, the Borough Zoning Officer; he heard that he recently suffered a house fire. Mr. Lampmann explained that he and his family are okay, and they are currently living in a rental house in Kinnelon. Additionally, he asked about hosting a Freeholder meeting in Butler. INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION FROM THE PUBLIC:

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public to speak.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way had several questions, 1. Why do we need the CAP bank ordinance if the budget is so low? 2. Is the Jet Vac truck being bonded and was it included in this budget? 3. The Gifford Street water main work will that include repavement of the road? 4. What is a special labor attorney? 5. Is lead testing being done on the water? Mr. Norman noted that the area around the new McDonald’s is becoming an eyesore with garbage and other debris, who is responsible for this area. He also wanted to inform the Borough that there are utility poles on Kiel Avenue that are so close to the roadway that they could be knocked down by a passing vehicle.

Mr. Kozimor explained that as part of the Budget process the State allows a municipality to increase above the CAP limit; as this provides for additional available funding in the event of an emergency. Mr. Lampmann and Mr. Kozimor explained that the Jet Vac truck was included in previous budgets under Capital Improvement funding and is not being bonded. Regarding Gifford Street, the Borough would like to repave the road however, if there is funding it would not be done for approximately six months. Mr. Lampmann explained that a special labor attorney is for personnel issues. Mr. Lampmann noted that the Borough Water supply is checked for lead. Regarding the poles Mr. Lampmann will check to see if they are Borough poles or Verizon poles.

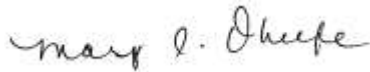

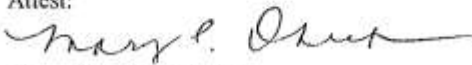

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Butler, in the County of Morris, finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2016 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body for said year, amounting final appropriations otherwise advisable and necessary; and, hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the to \$245,438.31 in excess of the in the Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated, as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

 - c. Cash deficit of preceding year
 - d. Reserve for uncollected taxes
 - e. Other reserves and non-disbursement items
 - f. Any inclusions of amounts required for school purposes.
2. That the provisions relating to limitation on increases of appropriations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and appropriations for exceptions to limits on appropriations found at N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.3 et seq., are fully met (complies with CAP law).
3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and N.J.A.C. 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.
4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
 - a. All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate and correctly stated,
 - b. Items of appropriation are properly set forth

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c. In itemization, form, arrangement and content, the budget will permit the exercise of the comptroller function within the municipality.

5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced and publicly advertised in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.

6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.
