MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

<u>Thomas Courtney, 20 Grace Valley Road</u> is here this evening to let the Mayor and Council know that Grace Valley Road is in need of repaving. Councilman Fox noted that while road paving has been completed for this year, he would review the road in Spring 2017 as part of the inspection for the 2017 roads projects.

<u>Camille Piccirillo, 97 Reservoir Avenue</u> is here this evening on behalf of the Library Board, noting that the restrooms currently used by the library need upgrading. Additionally, the changing area in the handicapped stall needs a mat as the old one was discarded and has not been replaced. Councilman McNear concurred with Ms. Piccirillo about the state of the facilities. Mayor Alviene will check into this and if funds are available in the 2017 budget for some upgrades.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way noted drivers continue to make illegal U-turns at the intersection of Route 23 and Kiel Avenue. Additionally, the new streetlight installed across from his home is shining directly into his house all night he would like to know if it could be adjusted to alleviate that. Mr. Lampmann will check into it and have adjustments made.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Councilman McNear</u> reporting on the Economic Development Committee noted that the Taste of Butler event was very successful, it was a sold out event with over 200 tickets sold. On the Board of Health, 40 Influenza vaccinations, 7 child health care services being provided, along with 2 adult care immunizations. December 6 there is a blood pressure screening please contact the Board of Health for more information. The Zika virus was discussed, as it is still in the forefront, he has additional information should anyone be interested.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reporting on Butler Power and Light noted that the Electric and Water Departments worked together to remove a few large trees at the Cascade Way filter plant, at a substantial savings to the Borough. Tree trimming continued in Kinnelon, a pole line upgrade commenced in the Smoke Rise swamp; special equipment was used to transfer energized three-phase spacer cable, the equipment was required for safety purposes. Upgrades and repairs were performed where needed. In Riverdale and West Milford, all was quiet for the month. All meters were read and recorded, delinquent accounts addressed, customer complaints and outage calls were resolved in a timely manner. The Butler Museum needs volunteers and help on Saturdays to keep the Museum open every Saturday, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

<u>Councilman Verdonik</u> reporting on Water and Wastewater noted that the bid for the replacement of the Manning Avenue water main will be awarded this evening. The total cost is slightly over \$97,000.00 of which \$80,000.00 is grant funding. Future Community Development Block Grant funding projects will be discussed tonight. A meeting is scheduled with several engineers regarding the connection between Bloomingdale and Butler; hopefully this will allow the project to proceed. More information will be provided later.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> regarding provided a synopsis of police department activities there were 31 motor vehicle accident of which 14 were reportable and 6 had injuries; summonses were issued as a result. 135 summonses were issued in October, one driving while intoxicated, 12 arrests were made for a variety of offenses. The Butler Fire Department held their annual Halloween party and it was very successful as always, there were approximately five to six hundred children attended.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reporting on Roads, Boonton Avenue repaving, milling and striping is complete. Borough vehicles are being prepped for the onset of winter and inclement weather, pothole repair will continue until the asphalt plants close for the winter.

<u>Council President Vath</u> there are two resolutions on the Agenda this evening 2016-111 canceling unexpended grant balances, it has no impact on the budget, 2016-113 is a Transfer resolution, so monies are transferred between accounts at the end of the year. 2017 Budget worksheets to the departments will be distributed prior to the end of November.

The dates are as follows May 5 and May 19, June 2 and June 16, July 7 and July 21, August 4 and August 18. The Mayor and Council approved the proposed dates, as the previous events have been very successful.

2016-18 An Ordinance Authorizing the Execution of an Inter-Municipal Agreement Establishing the New Jersey Public Power Authority, A Municipal Shared Service

Introduced: August 1, 2016 Advertised: August 7, 2016

Mr. Lampmann explained that the Ordinance was finally approved by the Local Finance Board, this will give the smaller utility companies many advantages, in addition to the savings that will result from this, an estimate given by Office of Legislative Services projects there will be \$72,000,000.00 in savings amongst all members over a five-year period. This has been a long time coming, but finally the Governor has signed the legislation this year.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way what is the size of this organization and what does this encompass. Mr. Lampmann explained that the maximum amount of members is nine, all of the municipal utilities, currently all are joining. The customer base will remain the same, however, power purchases will no longer be bought individually, this will allow for a larger purchase, usually at a lower rate as one of the benefits that we would be entitled to because of joining.

<u>Alex Calvi, 5 Butler Place</u> would any control be lost because of this. Mr. Lampmann explained that we could select what we use, as it is an "Al la Carte" menu. The only difference really is that power can be purchased at a better price. This will not influence day-to-day operations of the utility.

<u>Douglas Travers, 16 Western Avenue</u> as a power authority they have the ability to issue municipal debt for financing projects, does this open the Borough up to any exposure or liability as a community if they default. Mr. Lampmann explained that each municipality would be responsible for their own debt; each municipality would sign an agreement declaring individual responsibility for the debt. Additionally, under New Jersey State Law, a municipality cannot default, unlike in other states, there are procedures in place to cover any shortfall. The bottom line is Butler would not assume liability for anyone else if payments are not made by that municipality. The only exposure the Borough would have is for what they have authorized.

Seeing no one else come forward to speak Councilman Fox made a motion to close this public portion of the meeting and move the ordinance, second by Councilman McNear. All in favor.

Proposal for Environmental Cleanup at the Electric Building

Mr. Lampmann explained that the cleanup at the Department of Public Works Building is complete, however, three days after closure on that matter the Department of Environmental Protection sent a letter to the Borough regarding an open case from 1986 as well as another case from 1993. Mr. Lampmann believes that there may be confusion at the State regarding the 1993 case as it may be referring to the case that was just closed. The proposal on hand is for determining if there is any contamination. The 1986 case he believes was a disgruntled employee who wanted to have the Borough offices moved, nothing was ever found, but they are just trying to clean this up. Appointment of Helene Donargo to the Butler Library Board for the unexpired term of Marijane Brandau

Mayor Alviene explained that due to the untimely passing of Marijane Brandau, there is an opening on the Butler Library Board and he would like to appoint Ms. Donargo to complete the unexpired term. The Mayor polled the Council and they are in agreement regarding the appointment. The Clerk to notify Ms. Donargo of her appointment and administer the Oath of Office.

Butler Museum Operating Hours

Councilman Meier noted that Mrs. Spranzani had sent him a letter notifying him that she is stepping down as Chair of the Museum and the committee would like to split the position amongst two members. They also requested that the hours be adjusted from four Saturdays monthly to two due to both age and health of the members. The committee is looking to recruit members as they could use the help; he proposed the suggestion of the decrease in opening hours to the Mayor and Council. Mr. Lampmann noted that he reviewed the grant agreement that the Borough signed to obtain funding for the renovations recently completed to the Museum, one of the condition is that the facility must remain open a minimum of twelve hours a month. Mayor Alviene noted that the agreement must be maintained, or the funds may have to be repaid and they are sizable. Councilman Meier will bring this information back to the Committee for discussion.

INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION FROM THE PUBLIC:

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public to speak.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way questioned why the police reports do not appear in the Suburban Trends, as surrounding communities are in the paper, but he has not seen Butler. Mr. Myers from the Suburban Trends will check with the appropriate people in the office who cover Butler to find out what is happening. Regarding Boonton Avenue South in the area near Fayson Lakes, he acknowledged the Borough is not responsible for this; however, has there been any talk of Morris County repaving the road. Mr. Lampmann noted that repaving this road was not on any of the schedules that he has seen. Regarding a water main break that occurred on Kiel Avenue near Route 23, the road is not in great shape. Mr. Lampmann noted that the road is not in bad shape; however, they may be work occurring as part of work on the shopping center. Originally, the roadwork was supposed to be done by Morris County however, with the Transportation Trust Fund projects being put on hold due to lack of funding, the project may be done in 2017 at the earliest.

Ten restaurants participated, and the feedback was excellent. Perhaps in 2017 they will have two events in the Spring and the Fall.
