COUNCIL MEETING FEBRUARY 21, 2017 7:00 PM

The Council Meeting of the Butler Mayor and Council was opened by Mayor Alviene who indicated that the meeting was being held in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act having been duly advertised and posted in Borough Hall. This was followed by the Pledge to the Flag and a Moment of Reflection.

MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

George Stafford, 16 Kitchell Avenue, Wharton is present this evening representing the New Jersey Highlands Coalition, Association of New Jersey Environmental Commissions (ANJEC) and Keep it Green. He presented the Mayor and Borough Council with two resolutions one addresses some of the issues New Jersey is facing with its water supply that have been uncovered as a result of the current drought situation. A recently conducted study regarding the Water Supply Plan, has not been released, this resolution in support of clean water would ask the Governor and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to release the update immediately for the public to review and comment, with the intent to finalize, adopt and implement the plan. The other resolution is asking the state to provide funding for Open Space that will allow replenishment of the underground aquifers statewide. Mr. Stafford will forward the resolutions to the Clerk via email.

Allan Courtney, 20 Grace Valley Road is present this evening to voice his concern as a poll worker noting he took offense to the recent allegations that between three and five million people may have voted illegally. He stated that there is no way that this would have occurred at the Butler polling place as he and his fellow poll workers are well trained, any illegal voters would not be able to vote at the machines. Mayor Alviene noted that in Butler, everything is done by the book and he appreciates all the hard work that the poll workers do for the voting public.

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<u>Sean Davidson, 16 Sanders Place</u> wanted to check on the status of his request regarding the Pilgrim Pipeline and the status of the minutes of the February 7, 2017 Council Workshop meeting when he addressed the governing body regarding this issue. Ms. O'Keefe explained that the minutes were not yet complete for that meeting and they should be on for approval at the March 21, 2017 meeting. Additionally, regarding statements made by Mr. Stafford earlier in the meeting he feels that the while the location of the pipeline is not currently in Butler, it could affect other towns that may affect our supply and the real estate values.

Seeing no one else come forward to speak, a motion was made to close this public portion of the meeting:

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Council President Verdonik</u> regarding Finance the 2017 Budget process is ongoing, committees have met, the review is ongoing, however, the average increase in the last seven years has been \$60.77, and the additional review is to bring it down to that amount if not lower.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reporting on Roads noted that the winter has been uneventful as far as storms are concerned. Pothole repair is ongoing, if someone sees a pothole please let the Borough know so repairs may be done. Morse Avenue design is complete and is under review once complete we will get a project start date. Road and street signage replacement is ongoing.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> reporting on the Butler Fire Department they have added two new members and in 2016, there were 170 general alarms. 2017 Budget meetings were held with the Police and Fire Department.

<u>Councilman Calvi</u> regarding the Health department it has been relatively quiet, discussion took place regarding the Zika virus however, and currently it is not affecting New Jersey. The Board of Health is currently supporting a resolution that calls for additional state funding for lead related activities for local health departments, as the state has lowered the threshold for acceptable lead levels but has not provided any additional funding to meet the enforcement requirements for the new levels. Inspections were conducted on local food establishments, with most generally receiving a satisfactory, two establishments received a conditional rating were Panda World and Galaxy Diner, they will be reinspected.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reporting on the Electric Department a brand new pavilion was built by Borough employees, allowing electric supplies to be stored out of the elements. In Kinnelon, upgrades and repairs were made where necessary. In Butler, crews organized the supplies in the new pavilion. LED lights were installed in the rear parking lot area of Borough Hall, upgrades, new service where needed along with maintenance of bypass switches at the substations. In Bloomingdale poles were replaced where necessary, repair and or upgrades were completed. In Riverdale and West Milford, all was quiet for the month. All meters were read and recorded, delinquent accounts addressed, customer complaints and outage calls were resolved in a timely

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manner. Councilman Meier wanted to take a moment to thank the Tri-Boro First Aid especially Gayle Dunlap for giving her time to train all the employees of the Electric Department in Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillator Training. He wanted to pass his condolences onto the family of Clifford Guenter a sixty-nine year member of the Butler Fire Department. He held a unique position in the Fire Department, as he was the last Fire Chief to be appointed by the Mayor and Council and the first Fire Chief to be elected by the Butler Fire Department.

Councilman McNear reporting on the Water Department noted a change in the licensed operator from Keith Smith to Brian Pumo effective January 1, 2017. In addition, construction of the new 16" water main from the reservoir to the pump station is complete. Borough employees performed the work with an estimated savings of approximately 50% of the project costs. The Manning Avenue water main construction began on January 9 and completed on January 17, with funds provided by a Community Development Block Grant. As a reminder a drought warning remains in effect which may affect Spring hydrant flushing. The Department of Public Works responded to three sanitary sewer backups in January, the effected sewer mains were thoroughly cleaned and will be monitored in the future on an accelerated schedule, a video inspection will be performed on one of the mains as it has occurred in the past. Regarding the Economic Development Committee meeting held on February 20, 2017 the Concert in the Park series continues this year beginning in May on the second and fourth Fridays through August. Taste of Butler is scheduled for June 22, ticket price is \$35.00, it has been expanded to include sixteen different businesses and the event will be outdoors in tents adjacent to the High Point Brewery.

Letter from Jeff Ricker, Line Superintendent Butler Power and Light to Tri-Boro First Aid Squad thanking them for Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Training

Councilman Meier earlier spoke on the training received; Mr. Ricker thanked Gayle Dunlap for her hard work.

The Mayor and Borough Council asked that the resolution be forwarded to Chief Chimento for the Police Department's stance on this at the recommendation of Mr. Oostdyk and added for discussion to the Council Workshop Agenda for March 7, 2017. Mr. Lampmann agreed with getting the opinion of the Butler Police Department on this, as in reality local law enforcement is limited in its role regarding enforcement, as it is not a local issue.

Letter from GSM Architects Regarding the Ago Residence, 50A Maple Lake Road, Kinnelon

Mr. Lampmann provided a brief synopsis regarding the request before the Mayor and Council; this is a formal request for using a paper street as a means of ingress and egress. Councilman Fox feels that the road should remain as a paper street, the owners may pave it but they will be responsible for any paving and or improvements that are done to the road. Additionally, these conditions must be in writing and attached to the deed, in the past we have had properties that have special conditions supposed to be maintained by the property owner that have not been carried over with subsequent sales of the property. The property location for the house is in Kinnelon but the location for the driveway is in Butler.

Letter from Denville Mayor Thomas Andes regarding a Draft Rule regarding Ordinary Maintenance and Minor Work being considered by the Uniform Construction Code Advisory Board

Mr. Oostdyk explained that he has heard discussion in other towns, regarding the homeowner doing the work as opposed to a contractor along with the cost of permits and the scheduling of inspections. Mr. Lampmann explained that Butler had simplified the procedure years ago to avoid exorbitant permit fees and to make sure that homeowners procure permits.

Mr. Lampmann noted that the initial supply was donated, he is not aware that the replacement supply was paid for as he has not seen any invoices for it, he thinks it may have been donated or provided by Morris County. Regarding the discussion earlier resolution from Madison about a welcoming community, he has some concerns regarding the adoption of this based on a case he recently heard of where an illegal alien was convicted and deported eight times, had been incarcerated eight times and he returned, he doesn't believe the Mayor and Council would want that individual in Butler.

<u>Sandi Liss</u>, 409 <u>Main Street</u> wanted to request an additional speed limit sign be placed on the utility pole in front of her business, as people come off Hamburg Turnpike at a higher rate of speed than is permitted and this may alleviate the situation.
