# MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

<u>Sandi Liss, 409 Main Street</u> is here this evening on behalf of the Economic Development Committee as Chairperson she had two members who have not been attending meetings. She has attempted to contact Jeanne Scognamiglio and has not received a response to the emails; she would like to find a replacement for her. She has received a response from John Pellington who apologized for not attending the meetings explaining that due to a change in employment he is unable to attend the meetings. Chris Ziegler expressed interest in serving on the Committee. The Mayor and Council agreed he would be notified by the Clerk of his appointment.

James McGrath, 24 Valley Road had a question regarding Resolution No. 2017-86 Resolution in Opposition to New Jersey Senate Bills No. 1045 and 1046 Regarding the Open Public Meetings Act and the Open Public Records Act why the Mayor and Council are in opposition to these bills. Ms. O'Keefe asked for permission to respond to Mr. McGrath regarding this she explained that with the suggested changes information on juveniles could be made readily available with no option to redact certain information. Mayor Alviene also explained that we could not select what portions of the law can be followed. Mr. Lampmann explained that he recently attended a Joint Insurance Fund meeting where some towns have actually had to hire part time employees to handle Open Public Record Act requests as municipalities are being inundated with requests from various commercial entities looking for records dating back to 1900. The time expended gathering all of the information is great and no fee can be charged if the documents are provided electronically. Mr. Oostdyk explained that if the records are not provided a municipality can be sued, this has led to a small group of people that make requests and then start litigation for the sole purpose of trying to collect fees and money. The taxpayers are being ill served; municipalities are now creating customer lists for private enterprises, doing

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real estate agents jobs by searching out documents for them. Mr. McGrath asked would the state provide funding. Mayor Alviene explained that the Borough tries every day to get State funding for various other projects in the community to no avail. He also stated that it is his responsibility to protect the citizens of Butler, especially the children in the community.

Seeing no one else come forward to speak, Councilman Fox made a motion to close this public portion of the meeting:

# REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

Council President Verdonik regarding finance accounts are tracking very well this year. On for discussion this evening is the best practices worksheet which can be approved either tonight or it may be discussed this evening and approved at the October 3, Workshop meeting. The Economic Development Committee concert series concluded and it was a success. The Taste of Tri Boro will be held on November 9, 2017 at the Veterans of Foreign War hall on Carey Avenue, Butler. Recreation has begun planning for 2018 programs, attendance at Stony Brook was down this year, and they are looking into ways to increase membership.

Councilman Fox reporting on Roads the Morse Avenue preconstruction meeting will be held on Friday, September 22; at that point, determination will be made regarding start date and the schedule. More information will be available after the meeting and affected residents will be notified. Any monies remaining from this project will be used on additional roads for milling and paving, however, the work on Morse Avenue is expensive. The catch basins have been rebuilt; all water valves in the roadway have been inspected. The application for a Transportation Trust Fund grant for Paterson Hamburg Turnpike Resurfacing is complete and is on this evening's agenda for approval. Pothole repair is ongoing in preparation for the winter. Morris County has scheduled deck repair for the upper Main Street bridge, work is scheduled to begin in mid-October and will result in lane restrictions. The plan is for two-way traffic over the bridge along with pedestrian traffic; however, there may be lane restrictions during the construction.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> reporting on the Police Department statistics are as follows: 26 motor vehicle accidents reported, 34 summons, 2 driving while intoxicated arrests, 29 arrests for a variety of offenses. Prior to the meeting the members of the Public Safety Committee inspected a fire ladder truck as a replacement vehicle the Committee has seen three trucks, they will review the information and make a recommendation when completed.

<u>Councilman McNear</u> reporting on the Water Utility the Hasbrouck Avenue water main replacement project was completed on September 5, a new 8" water main is now active. The new pressure reducing station at the filtration plant is substantially complete, the newly installed valves have been tested and are operational, and the system will be activated later in the month, prior to hydrant flushing. Hydrant flushing is scheduled to begin on Monday, October 2, 2017,

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running through October 23, 2017. The State of New Jersey has released new legislation, the Water Quality Accountability act, which imposes additional requirements on reporting and implementing programs, including cybersecurity, asset management, valve exercise and hydrant flushing. Programs currently in use meet or exceed many of the new requirements. A minor sewer backup occurred on Belleview Avenue, roots were extending into the customers lateral line the Department of Public Works cleared the backup but informed the homeowner that the line needs to be cleaned out. The new sanitary sewer GIS map has been substantially completed; a small amount of locations need to be inspected for field accuracy.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reported on the Electric Utility noting that Butler Power and Light assisted with National Night Out making it a success for another year. Repairs, upgrades and new service where needed was addressed, all meters were read and recorded, delinquent accounts addressed, customer complaints and outage calls were resolved in a timely manner. The Electric Utility assisted in tree removal on Morse Avenue in preparation for the road repair at a great savings to the Borough. The Butler Museum will be closed on September 30, 2017 and will participate along with the approximately 20 other Morris County Museums in the Pathways to History event is scheduled for October 7 and 8, 2017. Volunteers are needed for the Butler Museum to assist in projects and the Saturday operation of the museum, those interested should call the Museum at 973-838-7222. The Morris County Tourism Bureau webpage has photos of the Butler Museum displayed along with some general information regarding the Museum.

<u>Councilman Calvi</u> reporting on the Board of Health noted that the Board of Health does not have a meeting until September 27, 2017. He wanted to share some points from the Butler School District Mental Health Awareness Committee meeting he attended s a lot of information being provided to the parents who attend the number of different workshops that will be held throughout the year. Members of the community are attending Youth Mental Health training allowing them to identify some of the issues that are affecting children today. He is trying to work with Mr. Cardinale, Interim School Superintendent to increase attendance at these workshops.

Mr. Lampmann noted that at Back to School Night he and the Mayor were able to arrange the HOPE ONE Van at the event. Attendance was great, training was available for the use of Narcan, which may eliminate an Opioid overdose, and has a high success rate in counteracting an overdose; quite a few parents attended and completed the training, they then received the Narcan. Mayor Alviene worked through Morris County and was able to have the HOPE ONE available for Back to School Night and at the Butler Library on Thursday, September 21 during the daytime. Mr. Lampmann noted that the Butler Municipal Alliance receives a little over \$11,000 in grant monies that will be used for education programs for both staff and community members for mental health awareness; coordination is being done through Mr. Cardinale, as he is closer to the students and children of the community. Mayor Alviene wanted to point out that this is an example of listening and addressing the concerns in the community. Mayor Alviene wanted to thank all involved for the September 11, Candlelight Walk, as it was a well attended and those in attendance proceeded in a solemn manner befitting the event.

#### RESOLUTION EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS REGARDING THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT AND OPEN PUBLIC RECORDS ACT

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee took action on Senate Bill Nos. 1045 and 1046, which amend the Open Public Meetings Act and Open Public Records Act, respectively, on June 29, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Committee released the bills to the full Senate without recommendation because the bills are unnecessary, unpopular with the public, and would result in significant financial and administrative burdens on municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the bills fail to adequately protect taxpayers, municipalities and, especially, municipal clerks from abusive, harassing, and purposefully confrontational individuals who submit voluminous requests for no legitimate reason; and

WHEREAS, the legislation would expand the Open Public Meeting Act to create impractical and burdensome requirements with respect to subcommittees and working groups established by the entire governing body, which would effectively limit the ability of small groups of local officials discussing issues of public concern for the purposes of informing the governing body; and

WHEREAS, under the bills, the responsibilities of municipal clerks, who the Legislature has already loaded with responsibilities beyond the scope of their office, would be stretched even further than current law requires without a single dollar of additional resources provided to, or authorized to be collected by, municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the bills would impose a financial burden on municipalities that would not be offset by a revenue source other than the property tax, making the bills unfunded

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mandates prohibited by the New Jersey Constitution; and

WHEREAS, some municipalities are better equipped than others to meet the burdens that would be imposed by Senate Bill Nos. 1045 and 1046, however, without assistance of any kind from the States or the courts, every municipality would be on its own to meet the myriad new requirements of the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Butler, that the Legislature is strongly urged to reject Senate Bill Nos. 1045 and 1046 and draft new legislation to modernize OPRA and OPMA while providing municipalities and clerks with the resources to effectuate these changes for the benefit of the public.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be filed with the legislative sponsors of Senate Bill Nos. 1045 and 1046 and Assembly Bill Nos. 2697 and 2699, the Speaker of the General Assembly, the President of the Senate, and the Governor, and all parties are urged to listen to the concerns of local officials and prevent Senate Bill Nos. 1045 and 1046 from becoming law.
