## **MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION**

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

<u>Sandi Liss, 409 Main Street</u> is here this evening on behalf of the Economic Development Committee as Chairperson she provided the Mayor and Council with the information on a prospective replacement for one of her members who has not attended meetings.

James McGrath, 24 Valley Road is speaking on behalf of a handful of residents who have an issue with the placement of the fire hydrant adjacent to the Veteran's Memorial at Butler High School. Mr. Lampmann explained that a proposal was never received prior to the installation of the fire hydrant, additionally, a sketch was just recently provided. Regarding the timing of the project, this grant was applied for in 2016 and discussion did take place with Butler High School regarding this project, as the project needed to be complete prior to school opening. Mr. Lampmann noted that he spoke with Engineer who designed the project who explained that the placement was required to be past the last service, this location puts it three feet beyond that. The Borough asked the engineer regarding moving the fire hydrant to the other side of the street, per the engineer as this is a federally funded project (Community Development Block Grant funding) every federal rule must be followed as there was not enough room for the hydrant to be placed elsewhere. After discussion the solution arrived at was, a pedestal was be erected to hold the locator book while concealing the fire hydrant. Mr. McGrath thanked Mr. Lampmann for his explanation of the events.

## **REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:**

<u>Councilman McNear</u> reporting on the Water Utility hydrant flushing is currently ongoing. Of the 346 fire hydrants, eight hydrants are out of service at this time. On October 10, a contractor damaged water service on Morse Avenue; service was restored in approximately three hours. The new pressure control facility at the Water Treatment plant is finished and scheduled to go into service on October 18. The Department of Public Works is currently conducting a trial of leak detection equipment that will pinpoint the location of underground leaks. Sewer collection has had no problems; options are being explored for the Harold J. Mathews, Jr. pump station to eliminate issues with clogs.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reported on the Electric Utility tree trimming continues on Fayson Lakes Road, and in various other areas. Stock levels are adequate for the upcoming winter months. Transformers no longer usable were recycled for credit; poles were set and transferred where needed. Repairs, upgrades and new service where needed was addressed, all meters were read and recorded, delinquent accounts addressed, customer complaints and outage calls were resolved in a timely manner. All was quiet in Riverdale. The Pathways to History event that Butler Museum was part of was a success approximately 50 to 75 people attended during the two-day event. Toys for Tots is scheduled to come through on December 2, with the train arriving at the Butler Museum at 1:55 p.m. and departing at 2:25 p.m., if you have toys please bring them to the Museum as the United States Marine Corp will appreciate the donation. Mayor Alviene wanted to thank the Museum Committee for their hard work as he attended the Pathways of History and found it very informative and enjoyable.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> reporting on the Police Department statistics are as follows: 24 motor vehicle accidents, 16 were reportable with five injuries. 175 summons issued, two driving while intoxicated arrests, 29 arrests for a variety of offenses. The Public Safety Committee met with the Butler Fire Department and discussed the potential purchase of a new ladder truck that will serve the needs of Butler.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reporting on Roads the Morse Avenue construction began on October 10, the focus at this time is on the drainage between Lowe's and the entrance to Myrtle Avenue, there have been some problems with placement, once this is complete the focus will shift to curbing and sidewalk replacement. Affected residents were notified prior to the start date and asked to submit any requests regarding the sidewalk and curb replacement, the engineer met and reviewed the concerns of approximately twenty residents; all of their concerns were addressed. Denville line striping will be working on Main Street on October 20. Morris County will be replacing the bridge deck on the upper section of Main Street work is scheduled to begin on October 18, there

will be lane restrictions, currently the plan is to keep the roadway open with traffic going in both directions during the project, police will be on hand to provide traffic control.

<u>**Council President Verdonik**</u> regarding finance revenue and expenditures are tracking very well this year. The Economic Development Committee is sponsoring the Taste of Tri Boro event it will be held on November 9, 2017 at the Veterans of Foreign War hall on Carey Avenue, Butler.
