The Council Meeting of the Butler Mayor and Council was opened by Mayor Alviene who indicated that the meeting was being held in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act having been duly advertised and posted in Borough Hall. This was followed by the Pledge to the Flag and a Moment of Reflection.

MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

Debbie Sammon, 80 Summit Avenue is here this evening to ask Mr. Lampmann about tree trimming in the Lake Edenwold section and paving of Outlook Street and Summit Avenue. She also asked if the street sweeper would be up in the Lake Edenwold area prior to winter. Mr. Lampmann explained that the paving on Greenwood Avenue is PSE & G doing repair work on the trenches; regarding the street sweeper, it is currently being refurbished, once the refurbishment is complete, the street sweeping will commence in the Borough.

Margaret Spranzani, 32 Cleary Avenue had a question regarding E-Waste collection in the Borough. Mr. Lampmann explained that the program began on August 1, if the item is small enough to carry in then bring it to Borough Hall during regular business hours, if the item is too large for one person to carry call in advance to make an appointment so a Borough employee may take it to the container at that time. She also wanted to know what could be done about plantings that obstruct the view at intersections. Mr. Lampmann asked that she provide him with addresses and he will forward that information onto the Zoning Officer to address.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way had questions regarding the recycling of rechargeable batteries. Mr. Lampmann informed him that he could bring them to Borough Hall for recycling. He also had a question regarding Ordinance No. 2018-16 he wanted to know if it was for the new Fire Truck. He was told that the Ordinance is for the purchase of a new Fire Truck.

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Bob Podstawski, 62 Marion Avenue questioned why where Butler Police attending a Rockaway Council meeting. Mr. Lampmann stated that there was MCREDS (Morris County Regional Emergency Deployment System) call out; Morris County assesses the situation and determines if there is a need for deployment, this is a mutual aid agreement of which Butler is a member. Mr. Podstawski then asked who pays the officers. Ms. O'Keefe explained that the officers receive compensatory time for those hours worked. Mr. Lampmann recalled that several years ago former Pro Football quarterback Michael Vick had an appearance here in Butler MCREDS was called out for assistance. Mr. Lampmann noted that the Borough incurred no charges for the assistance provided at that time, that it is a mutual aid system.

Don Moran, Morse Avenue is here this evening to invite the Governing Body, Borough Administrator and the Borough Clerk along with the residents of the community to attend an Open House at the Butler Fire Department on Thursday, October 11, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., additionally that is Fire Prevention week.

Seeing no one else come forward to speak, Councilman Fox made a motion to close this public portion of the meeting:

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Council President Verdonik</u> regarding finances they are tracking very well. Recreation is sponsoring two more events this year a Food Truck festival on October 6, 2018 from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Stonybrook and Spooky Stony is scheduled for October 27, 2018; there will be a haunted mansion set up; the time for Spooky Stony has not been determined yet.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reporting on Roads Morse Avenue is completed and striped, Tilcon returned to complete some needed repairs. The upper Main Street Bridge was resurfaced, finished and striped. There are some funds remaining from the Roads allocation in the 2018 budget, there will be milling and paving on the short section of Smith Street (corner of Spring and Smith), Councilman Fox stated that the road is in terrible shape. Replacement of the faceplates so the Borough complies with current storm water regulations is almost complete.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> reporting on the Police department 193 summons were issued, 2 driving while intoxicated, 13 arrests were made. Regarding the Fire Department 121 fire alarms an increase of 23%, training is now done with the entire department rather than individually. Turnout for training has been great.

<u>Councilman Calvi</u> the Water Department will be conducting the annual sampling for lead and copper content in the water. Required updates to the Borough's lead and copper sampling plans were completed in early 2018. The Borough is in full compliance with state and federal regulations regarding lead and copper. Hydrant flushing is scheduled to begin on October 8 it takes approximately 3 ½ weeks, a flushing post was installed on Western Avenue to improve the flushing within the neighborhood. Regarding Sewer, no backups have occurred nor any pump

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malfunctions, cleaning of sump station wet wells should be completed within the next two weeks depending on contractor availability.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reporting on the Electric Utility assisted with National Night Out; unfortunately, the weather interrupted the evening and was also responsible for a few power outages. All personnel attended mandatory training. Repairs, upgrades and new service where needed was addressed, all meters were read and recorded, delinquent accounts addressed, customer complaints and outage calls were resolved in a timely manner. All was quiet in Riverdale and West Milford. Councilman Meier read the following letter into the record:

My name is Ken Vesey and I live in Kampfe Lake, Bloomingdale. The times we live in when everyone has come to want and expect things instantly, I am constantly impressed with Butler Electric.

This past Saturday 9/15 my wife reached out to Butler Electric regarding occasional flickering on lights in our home. Within the hour you had a crew on the pole addressing the problem. The problem needed additional resources and 2 more crews joined the effort and an hour later the line was fixed and the flickering stopped.

All too often you read and hear about utility companies failing and citizens suffering because of this. I wanted to express my appreciation to you for always exceeding my expectations and proactively taking steps to insure your customers receive 100% service or as close to as possible.

The Butler Museum participation in the Pathways to History Tour is Saturday, September 22 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Sunday, September 23, from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., the theme this year is World War I, uniforms, artifacts and photos will be on display. The Butler Museum recently had 1100 slides digitized for use in the community.

<u>Councilman Travers</u> reporting on the Board of Health noted that there are no updates, as they do not meet during the summer months; the next scheduled meeting is September 26. He will be able to provide updated reports after the meeting. He will look into the status of the changes on the recently adopted ordinances.

Mayor Alviene wanted to thank all those who attended the 9/11 memorial event. There was a nice crowd of people in attendance and it was great to see the respect that was given. He thanked all the departments involved Police, Fire, Tri-Boro First Aid, Electric and the Department of Public Works, and of course the Borough Clerk Mary O'Keefe.

PRESENTATION OF CORRESPONDENCE, PETITIONS

Butler Museum and Historical Committee Request for an Amendment to the Borough Code to Allow for the Appointment of Members who are not Borough Residents

Ken Montanye, 117 Boonton Avenue, Co-Chair of the Butler Museum is present this evening to inform the Mayor and Council that the Museum is suffering from a severe shortage of members as some of the members are unable to attend due to illness, and there are a couple of openings. He stressed the need for more volunteers; he has tried various outlets for volunteers such as newspaper, social media and open houses. He is reaching out to the Mayor and Council for help in getting more volunteers as the Museum is required to be open 12 hours monthly as per the terms of the various grants that have been received from the Morris County Historic Preservation Trust Fund for the renovation and restoration of the Museum. He feels that the chapter of the code as it is written is vague. Councilman Meier feels that if someone from another municipality wants to join that should be okay, Mayor Alviene explained that the appointment to the committee is a Mayoral appointment. Mr. Lampmann asked the Borough Attorney if a guideline can be established that if the appointee is not a Borough resident they may not be an officer of the committee. Peggy Spranzani, former Chair of the Butler Museum for nineteen years, noted that non-residents may be members of the Museum but may not be in a position of handling money nor have they been in those positions in the twenty-four years she has been a member of the museum.

Request from Steve Mulligan for Borough Assistance for the Mission Honor Ceremony on October 27, 2018

Councilman Travers has been in contact with Mr. Mulligan, who is looking for Borough support for the following three elements: Support of Butler Police Department as far as closing certain streets to traffic during the ceremony, also the use of certain equipment from the Butler Fire Department and TriBoro First Aid Squad. Mr. Mulligan is trying to get a parachute jumper from the West Point; Councilman Travers explained to Mr. Mulligan that as this is school property permission must be granted from the Butler Board of Education for the use of school property, he asked that he receive copies of the permission from the Board of Education. A preliminary schedule of events was provided however, it is subject to change. Mayor Alviene stated that there needs to be a plan prior to the event, as many departments will be involved in the execution of the event. Mr. Lampmann noted that there should be a meeting to get a set plan and to curtail costs to the Borough.
