COUNCIL MEETING JULY 16, 2019 7:00 PM

The Council Meeting of the Butler Mayor and Council was opened by Mayor Alviene who indicated that the meeting was being held in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act having been duly advertised and posted in Borough Hall. This was followed by the Pledge to the Flag and a Moment of Reflection.

MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

Thomas Lightbody, 8 William Street explained that there is a situation with the house adjacent to his, the property had been abandoned and in disrepair, renovations are being done to the property, he has spoken with Bill Budesheim regarding the overgrowth of the yard, recently the lawn was mowed however, not the entire yard. There is a section of the property that was not mowed, as there seems to be some confusion on the part of the property owner as to who owns that property. The area in question is approximately a 4' by 25' area, which is never cut; when Mr. Lightbody was leaving to come to the meeting, the area in question was being cut. Mr. Lampmann will look into this to alleviate the issue.

<u>Frank Spizziri, 37 Third Street</u> is present this evening regarding the paving of Third Street, he would like to know what the time frame is for paving. Mr. Lampmann gave an estimate of mid to late August for the work to begin. A letter will be sent to the residents in that area to let them know the schedule.

Katie O'Neill, 72 Bartholdi Avenue she expressed concern regarding the return of the Pride Flag, she noted that they did not ask for a flagpole, they were told the Pride Flag would fly next June in the Borough of Butler. Mayor Alviene explained that at the Council Workshop Meeting on July 2, 2019 the item was listed on the Agenda, at that meeting the item was brought to a vote, the entire Council was polled at that meeting and they had concerns regarding the flagpole and flying of various. One of the main concerns is that you may not be able to limit what flags are flown and this has the potential to create problems in the community. Ms. O'Neill stated that the Library of Congress is an agency of the legislative branch of the United States Government they deal with many facets of governmental duties, such as patents, etc. She noted that the

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Library of Congress flies specific flags; she feels that we should follow what the Library of Congress does. Mr. Oostdyk explained that is one way to look at this, however, we must do research to see if that can legally stand. Mayor Alviene reiterated that there are concerns about the various groups that can apply and they may be offensive to some residents. Council President Verdonik noted that if a group requests to fly their flag and people find it offensive we may not be able to deny the request. Councilman Regis stated that he has concerns regarding what groups may approach the Borough regarding flying their flags. Mr. Oostdyk explained that this issue needs to be researched to avoid any legal actions that may occur because of flag requests. Councilman Travers concurred with Mr. Oostdyk.

<u>Kim (Colin) England, 398 Cambridge Drive</u> first time attending a municipal event ever, is very much in favor of the flying of the Pride Flag and does understand that hate groups may approach the Borough. There are organizations that maintain lists that monitor hate groups and could be contacted for those lists.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way has two questions regarding the construction signs and mark outs on Route 23. Mr. Lampmann explained that the Borough has not received any notification regarding the starting of construction. This is in preparation for paving of Route 23 they are also doing basin work. At the last Council Workshop meeting, he mentioned a drain on lower Main Street, Mr. Lampmann inspected the drain and the depression is not as great as was reported however, PSE & G has been contacted, as this is a gas test box, they will be coming out to reset the box. Mr. Lampmann believes that once the test box is reset the depression should be gone.

<u>Julia O'Neill, 72 Bartholdi Avenue</u> will not be able to attend the September 3, meeting so she would like to express her views on the flying of the Pride Flag she feels that Butler has become a lot more accepting since she graduated from Butler High School in 2016. She feels that it would be more positive than harmful; the world is changing and everyone has to change with it. Mayor Alviene explained that there are some issues that need to be addressed but feels that it was a very productive meeting.

Seeing no one else come forward to speak, Councilman Fox made a motion to close this public portion of the meeting:

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Council President Verdonik</u> Finance is tracking very well to this point in the year, 2020 budget preparation will begin in the fall, and the Police Union has submitted a written request regarding contract negotiations.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> regarding streets and roads the street sweeper has been repaired so street sweeping has resumed. The far end of Carey Avenue has been resurfaced, and regraded to improve the drainage. Catch basin and drainage repairs are ongoing on Hamburg Turnpike, in preparation for paving. Approval has been received from the Railroad to pave Hamburg

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Turnpike right to the tracks; we are awaiting the receipt of signed paperwork from the Railroad. Paving should begin sometime in August.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> the Fire Department will be doing a final inspection of the new ladder truck on July 24 and 25. The vehicle should be delivered to the Borough the week of August 5; the old ladder truck was sold to a Fire Department in Pennsylvania and the old SCBA filling station to a fire company in Tennessee. On the Police side, there were 33 motor vehicle accidents, 158 summons were issued for the month, 2 driving under the influence, and 9 arrests were made.

Councilman Calvi reporting on the Water Department the Northwestern Avenue water main project is in the final stages, acceptance training, activation of the new water main and transfer of water services, should be completed within the next two weeks. Routine water testing for lead and copper is complete; the Butler Water system is in full compliance with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection regulations. Participating customers will receive notification of the results later. A water leak on East Belleview Avenue was repaired on June 28; one household was affected by the leak. Meter readings have been completed routine mark outs and customer service calls were completed as needed. One sewer backup occurred on July 10 and it was an issue with the customer owned lateral.

Councilman Meier reporting on the Electric utility bids were obtained to replace a 34.5 kV breaker at the Main Street substation, this became necessary when the first breaker failed during testing and the manufacturer no longer supports the existing breakers. Both breakers will now be mirror images of each other and are manufactured by Siemens. Tree trimming continues in Kinnelon and Butler; a pole was replaced on Ridge Road Terrace, Kinnelon after a garbage truck ran into it. Repairs, replacements and new service hookups were completed where necessary. West Milford and Riverdale were quiet for the month. All meters were read and recorded, delinquent electric accounts, both residential and commercial were handled, outage calls and customer complaints were handled in a timely fashion. The Butler Museum is putting on Space Day on Saturday, July 20, 2019 the Museum will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Many artifacts will be on display, photographs from Astronaut Bill Pailes will be on display, he flew on the Atlantis mission.

<u>Councilman Travers</u> the Butler Health department met on June 26, details will be provided after the September meeting. Five area inspections were held of local eating establishments, on June 14 Stonybrook had a satisfactory report. Butler Library will be hosting a series of workshops on July 17, 24, 31 and August 7, the workshop is called Stress Less for Teens. If you know of someone struggling with addiction Pastor Chuck Corradino of the Church of the Nazarene has a group operating out of the Church called Teen Challenge, they deal with all kinds of addiction issues. 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BOROUGH OF BUTLER ORDINANCE NO. 2019-16

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AMENDED DEED OF EASEMENT IN BUTLER BOROUGH PARK FOR THE PEQUANNOCK RIVER BASIN REGIONAL SEWERAGE AUTHORITY PERMANENT SEWER EASEMENT

WHEREAS, the Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority (the "Authority") proposes to construct an 18" diameter sanitary sewer line underneath the Butler Borough Park and therefore it was necessary to remove the Green Acres restrictions for its construction, maintenance and use (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Project, it was necessary to remove the Green Acres restrictions for a permanent sewer easement consisting of 1,655.96 square feet (0.038 acres) in Block 14, Lot 30 situated in Borough Butler Park and set forth in a metes and bounds description prepared by DMC Associates, Inc. Professional Land Surveyors, dated August 13, 2018 (the "PRBRSA Permanent Sewer Easement") included in the "Green Acres Application, Pre-Application and Final Application for Minor Disposal or Diversion of Parkland, Proposed Sanitary Sewer Installation, Borough of Butler Parkland Lot 30, Block 14," (the "Green Acres Diversion Parcel"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has previously adopted a Resolution authorizing payment in the not-to-exceed sum of \$2,781.45 to the Borough of Butler, subject to approval by the State House Commission of the minor diversion or disposal necessary for PRBRSA'S Permanent Sewer Easement that was the subject of the Green Acres Application, as full Green Acres compensation for said diversion or disposal to be utilized towards installation of two new park benches and concrete base pads on Lots 1 and 30 in Block 14, to be completed by the Borough of Butler within six months of State House Commission approval; and

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WHEREAS, the NJDEP Commissioner and the State House Commission agreed to release the Green Acres Diversion Parcel from Green Acres restrictions under the terms and conditions approved by the NJDEP Commissioner on February 4, 2019 and by the State House Commission on May 9, 2019 (DEP SHC File #1403001) as described in Schedule C to the Green Acres Release and Compensation Agreement that is to be executed by the Borough of Butler; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted on June 18, 2019, the Borough of Butler adopted a Resolution authorizing execution of the Green Acres Release and Compensation Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Butler desires to convey to the Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority the 0.038 Green Acres Diversion Parcel upon full execution of the Green Acres Release and Compensation Agreement, and in accordance with the Local Lands and Buildings Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b)(1); and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Butler desires to authorize the execution of the amended Deed of Easement for the Green Acres Diversion Parcel in substantially the form on file at the offices of the Borough Clerk, subject to NJDEP's execution of the Green Acres Release and Compensation Agreement for the Green Acres Diversion Parcel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough of Butler, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to execute the amended Deed of Easement and, in substantially the form on file at the offices of the Borough Clerk, which shall not become effective until the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection executes the Green Acres Release and Compensation Agreement for the Green Acres Diversion Parcel.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this

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Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder of any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
