MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Alviene opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

Freeholder Deputy Director Shaw noted that he wanted to drop in on the various municipal meetings. He expressed his gratitude for all that is being done by municipal government during these trying times and for their leadership. He noted that Morris County has been doing a great deal and they are there to assist in any needs. Calls are being held with Mayor's on a weekly basis, he also noted that planning is ongoing to be prepared when the reopening begins. Morris County is also being very careful fiscally as revenues are down in certain areas that are directly affected by the lockdown. Freeholder Shaw also expressed his concern that Morris County has received no CARES funding, due to the population being 1.6% under the 500,000 threshold, he noted that Morris County Freeholder resolution is listed on the Agenda of tonight's meeting. He thanked all the first responders and the Morris County Sheriff's office. Mayor Alviene thanked Freeholder Shaw for his attendance and noted that if funding is received that Butler be included in the disbursement of any funds, the Mayor and Borough Council concurred that a resolution in support of CARES funding for Morris County be adopted.

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Hearing no one else come forward Councilman Fox made a motion to close this public portion of the meeting.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Councilman Fox</u> reported that street sweeping and routine maintenance continues on a regular schedule, the new storm water inlet grates and heads have been installed on Belleview Avenue and Hamburg Turnpike. The Department of Public Works will begin their inlet repairs and line striping over the next few weeks weather permitting. A sinkhole was discovered on Third Street, it was recently paved, and it appears to be related to an abandoned sewer lateral pipe, the Department of Public Works is working in conjunction with the homeowner to ensure that the pipe is actually abandoned. Once this is complete, the course of action will be determined.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> the Fire Department has responded to 66 alarms due to the COVID 19, most of the drills have been cancelled or postponed. Since the middle of March, several directives have been issued by Chief Finelli engine 342 has been designated as the first new apparatus to leave the firehouse as it is outfitted with hand sanitizer, Lysol wipes, chlorine bleach and other disinfectant equipment. Chief Finelli also closed the firehouses to the public; the only people allowed in are the Morris County Nutrition Center employees and Butler Firefighters for active alarms. He has implemented safety procedures to limit exposure or contamination by members of the Butler Fire Department. Regarding Butler Police criminal activity has been limited due to the pandemic.

<u>Councilman Travers</u> gave an updated report on the number of reported cases of COVID-19 in the Borough with four fatalities. The percentage of positive tests are on par with the State of New Jersey findings approximately 37% of those tested have resulted in positive findings. As of May 15, the number of new cases of COVID-19 is less than one per day in the Borough. Councilman Travers concurred with the passage of the resolution in support of Morris County receiving direct funding from the CARES act.

<u>Councilman Calvi</u> reporting on water, the installation of the AMI meter reading equipment is progressing with just under 12% of the system upgraded. New water mains have been installed at the Butler Plaza project acceptance testing is being conducted. Routine work orders and mark outs are being performed as needed. In the Sewer department the Department of Public Works responded to an alarm at the Woodland Avenue pump station, no sanitary sewer backups have been reported. Repairs to the Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority (PRBRSA) manhole at Elizabeth Street and Hamburg Turnpike in Bloomingdale have been completed; the Borough will bill the PRBRSA for time and materials.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> reporting on the Electric Utility annual dielectric boom testing and preventive maintenance is complete on all line trucks. All equipment is certified for live line use this year. Environmental clean-up has begun behind the electric building on Belleview Avenue

to remove contaminated soil. The crew split and alternating workweeks is working well in keeping our employees healthy. A high wind event on April 9, 2020 resulted in calls that were successfully handled. All faulted transformers were picked up for recycling on April 14, 2020. A conference call was conducted with Jim Lampmann and American Electrical Testing to set a tentative schedule to replace another 34.5kv substation breaker. Routine maintenance, repairs and upgrades were performed as needed. West Milford, Bloomingdale and Riverdale were quiet for the month. All meters were read and recorded, delinquent electric accounts, both residential and commercial were handled, outage calls and customer complaints were handled in a timely fashion.

<u>Council President Verdonik</u> regarding Finance the 2020 Municipal Budget was approved, he expressed gratitude to all the department heads who worked hard to keep spending down. The Borough is being very cautious in expenditures; some adjustments may be made to items or projects that are listed in the 2020 budget. Butler Recreation has cancelled Butler Day the opening of Stony Brook and the summer recreation program are on hold. The Economic Development Committee canceled the June concert, of the Concerts in the Park series, no decision has been made on the July and August concerts. The Food truck festival scheduled for Saturday, June 20, 2020 has been canceled.

Mayor Alviene noted that a small ceremony in commemoration of Memorial Day would be held on May 25 at 10:00 a.m. in Butler Park.

BOROUGH OF BUTLER ORDINANCE NO. 2020-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF 2020 AMENDED AND RESTATED SERVICE CONTRACT WITH THE PEQUANNOCK RIVER BASIN REGIONAL SEWERAGE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, in 1974, the municipalities of Bloomingdale, Butler and Kinnelon, created the "Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority" (hereinafter, the "Authority"), by their several ordinances duly adopted in the calendar year 1974 buy their respective governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, the Authority was created as a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey organized and existing under the Sewerage Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:14A-1 et seq., (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, exercising public and essential governmental functions to provide for the public health and welfare, with all necessary or proper powers to acquire, construct, maintain, operate and use works for the relief of waters in, bordering or entering the territorial boundaries of Bloomingdale, Butler, Kinnelon from pollution by sewage and industrial and other wastes arising from causes within such territory; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Riverdale was a customer of the Authority pursuant to the 1987 Service Contract between the Authority and Riverdale (the "1987 Riverdale Service Contract") and Riverdale is in the process of becoming a participant in the Authority by reason the securing of certain approvals pursuant to the Bond Resolution of the Authority and the enactment of an Ordinance by Riverdale and adoption of a resolution by the Authority in accord with the Act at N.J.S.A. 40:14A-4 (m)(i); and

WHEREAS, the Authority and Bloomingdale, Butler, Kinnelon and Riverdale desire to restate the existing obligations and amend the 1990 Amendment to the 1985 Service contract and the 1987 Riverdale Service Contract, and all amendments thereto, to true up the capacity allocations and locations of existing facilities; incorporate the Authority's policy relevant to connections to the System; revise the measurement volume of sewage and billing from flow metering to Equivalent Dwelling Units (EDUs) for the Operating Charge portion of the Annual Charge; incorporate the Authority's policy regarding surcharges for discharges in excess of a Participant's reserve capacity and waivers of the same, and related matters; and

WHEREAS, Butler has determined that it will be advantageous to it and to its residents to have sewage and other wastes originating from it or within its territorial boundaries and the District of the Authority disposed of by the Authority pursuant to the terms of the 2020 Amended and Restated Service Contract, and to be obligated to make payments for or with respect to any or all such service made or to be made available to it on the terms contained therein, in the amounts, and at the times provided for, and authorizes its proper officials to enter into and execute the 2020 Amended and Restated Service Contract reviewed by the Governing Body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Butler, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the 2020 Amended and Restated Service Contract in substantially the form on file of with the Clerk and hereby approved, which approval shall be evidenced by the signature of the Mayor on such Contract.

SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or federal or state agency of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A BUCKET TRUCK FOR THE ELECTRIC UTILITY OF THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$245,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$245,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH FOR FINANCING SUCH APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH

OF BUTLER, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvement described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance is hereby authorized as a general improvement to be made or acquired by The Borough of Butler, New Jersey. For the said improvement or purpose stated in said Section 3, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$245,000, said sum being inclusive of all appropriations heretofore made therefor.

Section 2. For the financing of said improvement or purpose and to meet said \$245,000 appropriation, negotiable bonds of the Borough are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$245,000 pursuant to the Local Bond Law of New Jersey. In anticipation of the issuance of said bonds and to temporarily finance said improvement or purpose, negotiable notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$245,000 are hereby authorized to be issued to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 3. (a) The improvement hereby authorized and purpose for the financing of which said obligations are to be issued is the acquisition by purchase of one (1) bucket truck for use by the electric utility of the Borough, including all equipment, attachments and

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accessories necessary therefor or incidental thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with the specifications therefor on file or to be filed in the office of the Borough Clerk and hereby approved.

(b) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued for said purpose is \$245,000.

(c) The estimated cost of said purpose is \$245,000.

Section 4. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

(a) The said purpose described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance is not a current expense and is a property or improvement which the Borough may lawfully acquire or make as a general improvement, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.

(b) The period of usefulness of said purpose within the limitations of said Local Bond Law, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the said bonds authorized by this bond ordinance, is five (5) years.

(c) The supplemental debt statement required by said Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey, and such statement shows that, while the net debt of the Borough determined as provided in said Local Bond Law is not increased by this bond ordinance, the gross debt of the Borough as defined in said Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided for in this bond ordinance by \$245,000, and the said obligations authorized by this bond ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

(d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$15,000 for interest on said obligations, costs of issuing said obligations and other items of expense listed in and permitted under section 40A:2-20 of said Local Bond Law may be included as part of the cost of said improvement and is included in the foregoing estimate thereof.

(e) This bond ordinance authorizes obligations of the Borough solely for a purpose described in subsection (h) of section 40A:2-7 of said Local Bond Law, and the said obligations authorized by this bond ordinance are to be issued for a purpose which is "selfliquidating" within the meaning and limitations of section 40A:2-45 of said Local Bond Law and are deductible, pursuant to subsection (c) of section 40A:2-44 of said Local Bond Law, from gross debt of the Borough.

Section 5. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer, provided that no note shall mature later than one year from its date. The notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer. The Chief Financial Officer shall determine all matters in connection with the notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the Chief Financial Officer's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. §40A:2-8. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time at public or private sale at not less than par and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the dates of delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body of the Borough at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include

the principal amount, interest rate and maturities of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the Section 6, punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the said obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Borough, and, unless paid from revenues of the electric utility system of the Borough, the Borough shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Borough for the payment of said obligations and interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Borough is Section 7. hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Borough Clerk and are available for public inspection.

Section 8. This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by said Local Bond Law.

- The Municipal Tax collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and issue estimated tax bills for the municipality for the third installment of 2020 taxes. The Tax Collector shall proceed and take such actions as permitted and required by P.L. 1994, c72 (N.J.S.A. 54:466.2 and 54:4-66.3).
- 2. The estimated tax levy for 2020 is hereby set at \$28,567,489.
- 3. In Accordance with law, the third installment of 2020 taxes shall not be subject to interest until the later of; the grace period or the twenty-fifth calendar day after the estimated tax bills were mailed. The estimated tax bills shall contain a notice specifying the date which interest may begin to accrue.
