The following streets are slated for milling and repaving as part of the Butler Road Repaving Project for 2022:

**Stony Hill Court, Tintle Road, Orchard Street, Smith Street (from Spring St to Roosevelt), Laurel Street, Sanders Place and a portion of Cleary Avenue (Struble to Aten Court)**

On or about ~~Friday September 23~~ **Tuesday September 27th**, weather permitting, work will begin on the milling and paving of the streets listed above. During the work there will be VERY limited access to your street during the working hours of the project. Every effort will be made to accommodate garbage and recycling pickups (which may occur earlier or later than your normal times) and access for emergency vehicles will always be available. Hours of work will be 7AM-5:00PM.

Currently the schedule is as follows but may be subject to change based on weather:

**Milling:** Stony Hill Court, Tintle Road, Orchard Street, Smith Street and Laurel Street

**Milling:** Sanders Place and the portion of Cleary Ave from Struble Ave to Aten Court

~~Tuesday 9/27~~ **Thursday 9/29**

**Paving:** Stony Hill Court, Tintle Road, Orchard Street, Smith Street and Laurel Street

~~Wednesday 9/28~~ **Friday 9/30**

**Paving:** Sanders Place and the portion of Cleary Ave from Struble Ave to Aten Court

**PLEASE REFRAIN FROM PARKING ON THE STREET DURING THIS PROJECT.**

Emergency No Parking Signs will be posted to remind you not to park on the street.

**Road surface conditions will require extra care when driving and walking once the road has been milled.** Please use caution and drive slowly until the paving has been completed.
