Butler Fire Dept. Fire Watch log

N.J.A.C. 5:70-3,901.7 Systems out of service. Where a required fire protection system is out of service, the fire dept. and the fire code official shall be notified immediately, and where the fire official determins that an imminent hazard exists pursant to N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.16. The building shall be either evacuated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.17 or an approved fire watch shall be provided for all occupants left unprotected by the shut down until the fire protection system has been returned to service. Where utilized, fire watch shall be provided with not less than one approved means for notification of the fire dept. and their only duty shall be to perform constant patrols of the protected premises and keep watch for fires.

1. Continually patrol the area, structure or facility and document the patrol a minimum of once every hour.

2. Be trained in the use of a fire extinguisher and have one accessible at all times.

3. Be capable of communicating with building occupants and the fire department to notify them about fires or other emergencies.

4. Maintain a record of the Fire Watch for inspection by the Authority Having Jurisdiction.

5. If the fire watch last more than a day, use more copies
