

## Monday

### **Yard waste (Seasonal)**

Yard waste **MUST** be recycled in biodegradable paper bags (no ripped/wet or with any debris protruding) or trash bin. Brush must be a maximum length of 4 feet, maximum diameter of 4 inches and tied together in a bundle no heavier than 25 pounds.

## Tuesday

### **Garbage**

Window panes/mirrors are considered garbage. X out glass with tape. Fiber glass is accepted tied in bags.

## Wednesday

### **Freon- Last Wednesday of every month, appointment needed.**

Register via phone or email with Health Department by the Wednesday before pick up.

**Examples:** refrigerator (doors removed) pool heater, air conditioner, dehumidifier

## Thursday

**Recycle-** No hardcover books, stickers, label-paper, waxed-paper or Styrofoam accepted.

### **Heavy Metal – Done quarterly, 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the quarter**

If missed due to snow, pick up will be the next day.

**Examples:** Bed frame, bicycles, dishwasher/washer/dryer (doors do not need to be removed), snow blower/lawn mower (gas and oil caps must be removed and fully emptied), patio umbrella, bbq grill, cast iron grates, water heater, treadmill, etc...

\*\*Will not take propane tanks.

## Friday

### **Bulk**

Bulk must be cut down to 4 feet or less and free of nails. Please remove legs from tables, disassemble furniture when possible. Vinyl siding is accepted but must be cut under 4 ft and bundled together no more than 25 lbs. **No metal or electronics will be taken.**

**Examples:** mattress/box spring, disassembled furniture, wooden fence posts, dried out paint cans w/o lid.

### **Construction Materials – limit 2 cans**

**No** cement/concrete, **no** nails, screws, nuts or bolts.

If kept in black construction bags, do not close the bags, no objects protruding out or ripping open the bag. Bins or bags must be 30lbs or less, limit two.

### **Electronics**

**Friday's only 1:30pm to 3pm.** No appointment necessary, drop off at DPW garage cross from Senior Center at 9 Ace Rd in front of the yellow shipping container on right hand side.

**Examples:** microwaves, computer towers and monitors, printers, vacuums and tvs.

### **Garbage**

\*\*If a garbage or recycling pick up is missed due to snow they will pick up on the next scheduled day.

Butler does not have a pick up for tires or stone/concrete; please check with local retailers, private haulers or the MCMUA for events.

**Alkaline batteries** can be thrown out in garbage, please tape the terminals. Not to be recycled.

**Lithium batteries** must be dropped at collection bin located at Butler Lowes, Home Depot or Staples

**Propane Tanks** – Home Depot
