BOROUGH OF BUTLER'S APPLICATION FOR  
APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN ITS LEVELIZED  
ENERGY ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE**

**TO THE MUNICIPAL CLERK ADDRESSED AND  
CUSTOMERS OF THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER:**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on February 1, 2020, the Borough of Butler filed a petition (“Petition”) with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“Board”) for a proposed decrease in its Levelized Energy Adjustment Charge (“LEAC”) rate (BPU Docket No. ER20010105).

The Petition provides that the present LEAC rate, which is \$.087989 per kilowatt hour, should be decreased to \$.064945 per kilowatt hour (a \$.023044 per kWh decrease) for all classes of customers. According to the Petition, the LEAC is adjusted by increasing or decreasing the rate quarterly subject to a rate cap of \$.151718 per kWh. The Petition proposes that the new LEAC rate be in effect for services rendered after April 1, 2020.

If the proposed LEAC rate is implemented on April 1, 2020, the average bill impact for a residential customer, inclusive of the 6.625% New Jersey Sales and Use Tax, served by the Borough of Butler in Bloomingdale, Riverdale, Kinnelon or West Milford, using the following kilowatt hours, would be as follows:
