The Council Meeting of the Butler Mayor and Council was opened by Mayor Martinez who indicated that the meeting was being held in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act having been duly advertised and posted in Borough Hall. He welcomed those present to the meeting. This was followed by the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of reflection.

MEETING OF PUBLIC AND INVITATION FOR DISCUSSION

Mayor Martinez opened this portion of the meeting to the public for discussion.

Bob Norman, 31 Cascade Way wanted to know what the status is of the repaving of Park Place, he understands that the company that installed the new sewer system, piping, etc. did not wish to do the repaving, so they would give the funds to the Borough to do the repaving. Mr. Lampmann explained that this issue is up for approval at the Pequannock River Basin Regional Sewerage Authority (PRBRSA) meeting of June 16, 2021. Once that is approved by the PRBRSA then it will be part of the road resurfacing that the Borough does yearly. Council President Verdonik clarified that the Borough will pave the entire intersection with the funds received from the contractor, as opposed to the PRBRSA contractors doing road patching at the project site. Mr. Lampmann explained that all affected areas will be paved. The paving should be done sometime in August. Mr. Norman wanted to know if the Borough is encouraging the opening of a marijuana store here in Butler. It was explained that the Borough is not encouraging they are allowing the opening of a store but the location is limited to the Highway Commercial zone.

Frank Blatterman, 46 Maple Lake Road he thanked the Police Department, Department of Public Works and the Electric Company for all the hard work they do throughout the year. He has an issue with the postal service as he shares the same address with a home in Kinnelon; he also has issues with package deliveries. He requested that there be a joint effort between Kinnelon and Butler to solve this problem. Councilman Calvi suggested that the letter "B" be added to Butler residences and "K" be added to Kinnelon residences to alleviate this issue. Mr. Lampmann asked would the deed be affected, Mr. Woods said it might not affect the deed.

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Councilman Meier suggested that Kinnelon could change its' numbering system. Mayor Martinez will follow up with Mr. Blatterman.

<u>Nichole Gawronski, 47 Valley Road</u> is present this evening to speak on speeding on Valley Road perhaps better signage could be installed, when she moved here there was a digital sign, it has since been removed. As there will be no busing available there will be more children walking to and from school. She noted that people tend to speed down Valley Road and Roosevelt Avenue.

<u>Mariella Howe, 13 Roosevelt Avenue</u> she feels that many people use Roosevelt Avenue as a pass through for the various schools, downtown Butler and Kiel Avenue. She requested that perhaps the placement of a rumble strip. She feels that this issue could affect people moving into the Borough. Councilman Regis stated that he would request the speed trailer be put on Roosevelt Avenue to remind drivers to slow down.

Dominic Affinito 34 Valley Road he is a 27 year resident, he noted that cars are flying up the hill; he is having trouble getting out of his driveway. He noted that people are speeding up the hill; he requested that perhaps the Police should use radar.

<u>Nadia Cartelli, 16 Center Street</u> her main concern is for the students that are walking to and from school and the lack of what she feels are proper sidewalks on that street. She does not allow her son to walk home from school as there are no sidewalks and she is concerned for his safety.

Mr. Lampmann explained that rumble strips are extremely noisy.

Seeing no one else come forward to speak, Councilman Fox closed this public portion of the meeting.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS:

<u>Council President Verdonik</u> finances are trending very well for the year; COVID-19 expenses are being handled. Regarding the Economic Development Committee the Concerts in the Park are scheduled for the fourth Fridays in June, July and August, the Bed Race will be held in October.

<u>Councilman Fox</u> regarding Roads the Department of Public Works (DPW) is performing routine maintenance and street sweeping as needed. An emergency repair was completed for a collapsed storm drain on Walnut Lane; crews are currently working on repairs to additional storm drains throughout the Borough. The DPW also assisted in painting the pool at Stonybrook in preparation for the 2021 season. On the agenda tonight is the bid award for the Western Avenue Improvements, it will be awarded to Marini Brother Construction Co., Hackensack, New Jersey.

<u>Councilman Regis</u> the Butler Police Department reports there were 25 motor vehicle accidents, 22 considered reportable, 150 summonses were issued and the officers made 3 arrests for a variety of offenses. The Butler Fire Department has responded to 102 alarms, 3 department drills are being conducted monthly, along with one department and one officers meeting. Driver training continues on all the apparatus. They are experiencing problems with the new fire truck it is currently in for service.

<u>Councilman Calvi</u> reporting on the Water Department customer service mark out requests have been completed as needed. The automated meter reading system is, ongoing 1/3 of the meters have been upgraded, hydrant flushing is complete, hydrant repair and replacement continue as needed. The water main replacement project on South Gifford Street was completed ahead of schedule. Sewer routine maintenance and inspections have been completed in a timely manner; crews responded to and cleared a sewer backup in the area of Decker Road. The DPW wanted to recognize Joe Scognamiglio on his promotion to Public Works Repairer.

<u>Councilman Meier</u> with summer approaching adequate transformers and supplies are on hand. In Kinnelon repairs, equipment replacement, new connections and upgrades are complete. In Butler, a service pole was replaced and an additional feed was installed on Myrtle Avenue along with temporary service at the proposed Wawa location at Butler Plaza. In Bloomingdale, crews spent a considerable amount of time on two large upgrade projects; these projects are not yet complete. Replacement poles and hardware were installed; upgrades were done in an area where a road and sidewalk replacement project was scheduled. Riverdale and West Milford were quiet for the month; all meters were read and recorded for the month. Delinquent commercial accounts, customer complaints, and outage calls were handled in a timely fashion. The museum will be open the first and third Saturdays monthly he noted that it is a worthwhile experience with all the items to see and history to read.

<u>Councilman Piccirillo</u> the Borough of Butler Board of Health 1 pending communicable case of Hepatitis B, 1 case of Hepatitis A currently there are 900 cases of COVID-19 and 11 COVID-19 related deaths in the Borough of Butler. On June 11, 2021, the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine was administered; there were 38 individuals on June 11, for those requiring the second dose.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-15

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH CHAPTER 68, "CANNABIS," OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER FOR THE LICENSURE OF CANNABIS ESTABLISHMENTS AND REGULATION OF CANNABIS USE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Butler, in the County of Morris and State of

New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler shall be amended by the inclusion

of a new Chapter 68, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

Chapter 68

CANNABIS

ARTICLE I

Sales

- § 68-1. Purpose.
- § 68-2. Word usage.

§ 68-3. Licenses.

ARTICLE II

Permitted License Type and Conditions for License

- § 68-10. Taxation.

ARTICLE I Sales

§ 68-1. Purpose.

This Article is enacted to regulate the sale of cannabis products within the Borough of Butler in accordance with the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of New Jersey, entitled "New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act," P.L.2021, c.16 (hereinafter referred to as "Act") and its supplements and amendments.

§ 68-2. Word usage.

For the purpose of this Article, words and phrases shall have the meanings given in the Act.

§ 68-3. Licenses.

- A. Laws applicable. All applications for licenses, all licenses issued and all proceedings under this Article shall be in accordance with the Act, rules and regulations referred to in § 68-1 and all other applicable laws of the State of New Jersey.
- B. Issuing authority. The Clerk of the Borough is authorized and empowered to issue licenses for the retail sale of cannabis in the Borough in accordance with Chapter 150.
- C. License applications; provisions. No license shall be issued except after written application presented by the proposed licensee in such form and upon complying with the provisions of this Article.
- D. License fees. The initial license fee shall be \$1,000.00. The annual license fee shall be \$500.00.

§ 68-4. Hours; sale to certain persons.

- A. Hours of sale. The holders of licenses in the Borough shall not sell cannabis between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- B. Sale to certain persons. No licensee shall sell, nor shall any licensee suffer or permit the sale, service or delivery of any cannabis product, directly or indirectly, to any minor under the age of 21 or any intoxicated person, nor permit such persons to congregate in or about the licensed premises.

§ 68-5. Persons under legal age for consumption.

- A. Presence. No person under the legal age of twenty-one (21) for the purchase of cannabis products shall be allowed in any premises where cannabis products are sold.
- B. Purchase of cannabis products by persons under the legal age. No person under the legal age for the consumption of cannabis products shall consume purchase, attempt to purchase, or have another purchase for him any cannabis product on any premises licensed for the sale of cannabis products.
- C. Purchase of cannabis products for persons under the legal age. No person shall purchase or attempt to purchase cannabis products for a person under the legal age for the consumption of cannabis products.
- D. Misstating age. No person shall misrepresent his age or the age of another person for the purpose of inducing any licensee or his employee to sell, serve or deliver any cannabis product to a person under the legal age for consumption of cannabis products or to permit a person under the legal age for the consumption of cannabis products to remain on any premises in violation of Subsection A.

§ 68-6. Revocation of licenses.

- A. Any license issued under this Article may be suspended or revoked for violation of any of the provisions of this Chapter or any provisions of any applicable statute or any of the rules or regulations of the State of New Jersey.
- B. Unless the immediate suspension is necessary for preservation of public safety, proceedings for the suspension or revocation of any license issued under this Article, shall be commenced by the service of a five-day notice of charges preferred against the licensee by the Clerk and affording a reasonable opportunity for a hearing before the Borough Council. Licenses may be suspended or revoked for any violation of this Chapter.
- C. Suspension or revocation of a license shall be in addition to any other penalty which may be imposed for a violation of this Article.

D. Any license issued by the Borough of Butler under this Article shall be suspended and/or revoked upon the suspension and/or revocation of the licensee's license issued by the State of New Jersey and/or the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission.

§ 68-7. Violations and penalties.

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Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this article shall be subject to such penalties as are provided for in Chapter 230, Violations and Penalties, of the Code of the Borough of Butler.

ARTICLE II Permitted License Type and Conditions for License

§68-8. License limited to Retail Establishments.

The class of cannabis license permitted in the Borough shall be for a Cannabis Retail Establishments and Medical Cannabis Dispensaries. No license for any other class of Cannabis establishment, including cannabis cultivators, manufactures, distributors, wholesalers, testing facilities, or delivery services, shall be available.

§68-9. Conditions for Issuance and Renewal of License.

In addition to the requirements as provided in Article I, the following conditions are required for the issuance and renewal of a Cannabis Retail Establishment license:

- A. Applicant must possess any and all required licenses, permits or authorizations from the State of New Jersey and/or the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission for the operation of a Cannabis retail Establishment.
- B. The Cannabis Retail Establishment shall be located in the HC Zone-Highway Commercial District.
- C. The Applicant has received conditional use approval from the Planning Board of the Borough of Butler.
- D. No on-premises consumption or use of cannabis shall be permitted.
- E. Only cannabis related products may be sold on-premises.
- F. Cannabis Retail Establishments must be equipped with security cameras with coverage of exterior parking and loading areas, points of entry and egress, areas open to the public, and cannabis storage areas. Security footage must be maintained for the period required by State law and be subject to immediate inspection and access by the Borough of Butler Police Department upon request.
- G. Cannabis Retail Establishments must prominently display signage indicating that no individual under the age of twenty-one is permitted on the premises and that the on-premises consumption or use of cannabis, food, alcohol, tobacco is prohibited.
- H. Any Cannabis Retail Establishment must possess and prominently display all licenses required by the State of New Jersey and the Borough of Butler for operation.
- Cannabis Retail Establishments must be equipped with lockable doors and windows and a security system with audible alarm and direct or third-party notification the Borough of Butler Police Department.
- J. All cannabis products and cash must be stored and secured in a locked safe or hardened container securely attached to the premises.
- K. Licensee shall be current on all State and municipal tax payments.

§ 68-10, Taxation.

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All Licensees under this Chapter shall be subject to quarterly remission of municipal taxes as required set forth in Article II of Chapter 210 and shall be compliant with the requirements therein.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to

the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the

manner provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 143, LAND USE, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER FOR THE REGULATION OF CANNABIS USES AND ESTABLISHMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Butler, in the County of Morris and State of

New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 143, "Land Use," Article XVII, "Special District Regulations," of the Revised

General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler shall be amended by the inclusion of a new Section 123.5, which

shall read in its entirety as follows:

"§143-123.5 Cannabis Retail and Medical Cannabis Dispensary Conditional Use in HC Zone,

The operation of Cannabis Retail Establishments as defined by P.L.2021, c. 16, and Medical Cannabis Dispensaries shall be a conditional use in the HC Zone—Highway Commercial District as provided in Article XX of this Chapter."

Section 2. Chapter 143, "Land Use," Article XX, "Conditional Uses," of the Revised General

Ordinances of the Borough of Butler shall be amended by the inclusion of a new Section 173, which shall read in

its entirety as follows:

"§143-173 Cannabis Retail and Medical Cannabis Dispensary Establishment.

A. Cannabis Retail Establishments and Medical Cannabis Dispensaries shall only be permitted in the HC Zone-

Highway Commercial District.

- B. Minimum setback and bulk requirements shall be as set forth in §143-118 Schedule D, except as to existing structures.
- C. No drive-through window shall be permitted.
- D. Minimum useable floor area of 1,200 square feet.
- E. No Cannabis Retail Establishment or medical cannabis dispensary shall be located within 2,000 linear feet of another Cannabis Retail Establishment or medical cannabis dispensary as measured from the property lines.
- F. No Cannabis Retail Establishment or medical cannabis dispensary shall be located within 1,000 linear feet in any direction of a school, licensed daycare facility, church, synagogue, or religious worship center, public park, library or a licensed substance abuse disorder clinic or facility, as measured from the property lines.
- G. Hours of operation shall be limited to 7 a.m. through 11 p.m. daily."

Section 3. Chapter 143, "Land Use," Article XVIII, "General Provisions," Section 128, "Prohibited

Use," of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler shall be amended by the inclusion of a new

Sub-Section C, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

"§143-128 Prohibited Use

C. Except as otherwise provided in Articles XVII and XX of this Chapter, the operation of all classes of cannabis establishments as defined by P.L.2021, c. 16, including but not limited to, cannabis retailers, cultivators, manufactures, distributors, wholesalers, testing facilities, or delivery services, are expressly prohibited uses within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Borough of Butler."

Section 4. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 210, "TAXATION," OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BUTLER TO INCLUDE A NEW ARTICLE CONCERNING CANNABIS SALES TAXATION.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Butler, in the County of Morris and State of

New Jersey, as follows:

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Section 1. Chapter 210 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler shall be amended

by the inclusion of a new Article II, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

ARTICLE II Taxation of Cannabis Sales

§ 210-3. Taxation of Cannabis Sales and Transfers.

There is hereby imposed a sale and transfer tax on all cannabis products sold by cannabis retailers within the Borough of Butler. Such tax will be imposed at time of sale or transfer and shall further be imposed upon the value of cannabis products transferred by any concurrent license holder operating more than one establishment of any class, to or from the license holder's establishment located within the Borough of Butler to any or from the license holder's other establishments, whether or not such establishment is located within the Borough of Butler.

§ 210-3. Rates.

The tax rate for the retail sale of any cannabis product shall be 2% of the value of each receipt or transaction of sale. The tax rate for any transfer by concurrent license holder of cannabis products shall be 1% of the market value of the transferred cannabis product.

§ 210-4. Remission of taxes.

Every cannabis establishment and/or licensee shall remit taxes collected and due and owing on a quarterly basis to the municipal chief fiscal officer, along with certified copies of sales receipts and product transfer ledgers or documentation. The dates of tax remission shall be on or before April 1, July 1, October 1 and January 2, or as established by the chief fiscal officer. Each licensee shall certify to the truth and accuracy of the receipts and product transfer ledgers or documentation, and shall remit a return in a form determined by the chief fiscal officer.

§ 210-5. Delinquent taxes.

All unpaid taxes as required under this Article shall be subject to the accrual of interest and penalties at rates and penalties set forth and established for delinquent ad valorem taxes within the Borough of Butler.

§ 210-6. Liability for taxes owed.

Each cannabis establishment owner and/or licensee shall be personally liable for any and all taxes imposed under this Article and any interest and penalty accruing thereon. In addition, any unpaid balance and interest and penalties accruing thereon shall constitute a lien on the real property in which the cannabis establishment is located and such liens shall be enforced in the same manner as municipal tax liens.

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§ 210-7. Audit.

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Every cannabis establishment and/or licensee within the Borough of Butler is subject to audit, no greater than once per annum, of the establishment's or licensee's business records, receipts and accounting books, such audit to be performed at the chief fiscal officer's discretion, by a certified public accountant. Every cannabis establishment and licensee shall be obligated to fully comply with the requirements of an auditor. Failure to cooperate with the audit, or any misrepresentation or fraud committed by the establishment or licensee, shall result in the immediate suspension of the license.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent

jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the

section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to

the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the

manner provided by law.
