Brandi Greco then read the Pride Month Proclamation declaring June as Pride Month in support of the LBGTQ+ Community.

Mayor Martinez then opened the meeting to the public.

Angela Drucker – 119 Bartholdi Ave approached the Mayor and Council and asked that they consider amending the ordinance regarding owning chickens. She states that our ordinance requiring 5 acres is excessive and they require much less space. She also stated all of our neighboring towns now allow them. She agrees roosters should still be prohibited due to their noise, but thinks we should consider changing our ordinance regarding chickens. Mayor Martinez stated that this is on the agenda for a Planning Board workshop and encouraged her to attend and speak at that time.

Next, she inquired about creating a community garden in the area where the animal shelters' dog run was. She stated it hasn't been used in years for it's intended use and would like the Borough to get the land back from the animal shelter and create a garden there.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES AND DEPARTMENT HEADS

Council President Verdonik reported that he was unable to attend the EDC meeting. In Recreation, Stonybrook will be opening shortly, with numerous programs planned including a corn hole tournament. The playground had its grand opening and he thanked all those involved in helping make it happen. In Finance, he stated although costs and interest rates are up, we are holding steady.

Councilwoman Morley reported on the Board of Health inspections, both regular and those due to complaints. All are now free of violations.

Councilman Calvi stated we had 24 MV accidents with 14 considered reportable and 2 injuries. Zero DUI's issued. 190 summonses were issued from 389 stops. 11,183 random license plates checks were processed. There were 5 arrests for a variety of criminal offenses. Police continuing education and training is ongoing.

Councilman Meier reported in the Electric Dept., a new bucket truck was ordered to replace a 2010 model. The delivery time is 2 years and at a substantial cost increase over the last vehicle, but this is still better than the 5 year lead time offered by Altec. He stated all interior work on the new pole barn has been completed. Rubber gloves and sleeves were changed out per OSHA guidelines. He then reported a summary of all services and repairs including at Richard Buter School. Veteran banners were installed and will remain up until after Veterans Day. All meters were read and reported for the month. Delinquent accounts both residential and commercial were handled. All outage calls were repaired promptly.

For the museum, he said they now have a complete set of all Butler yearbooks on hand. He reminded everyone they are open on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month. The 5th grade visited both the museum and Manning Avenue Cemetery as part of a field trip.

Councilman Piccirillo reported that he has no water or sewer report because he was unable to open the e-mail.

- **Section 2.** Chapter 68, "Cannabis" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Butler, Section 68-9 "Conditions for Issuance and Renewal of License", shall be amended by the addition of new subsection L. which shall read as follows:
 - L. The licensed premises must be open for business within 60 days of the issuance of a license.
- **Section 3**. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.
- **Section 4**. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **Section 5**. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.

Further, pursuant to the FY 2023 Appropriations Act (P.L. 2022, Chapter 49), DCA received a grant-in-aid amount of \$3,900,000 for P.L. 2021, c. 182, for a total of \$7,800,000 in appropriations to effectuate the purpose of the Act.

WHEREAS, DCA has allocated \$7,000,000 of this appropriation to the development of the Lead Grant Assistance Program ("LGAP") for the issuance of grant funds to municipalities for the purpose of assisting in municipal compliance with P.L. 2021, c. 182.
